
HEROES OF HOPE

Understanding Dad™: A Program for Moms

Think about how the most vital relationships in your life have shaped who you are. Our new program **Understanding Dad™:**A **Program for Moms** focuses on building that critical relationship between mothers and fathers in Wayne County.

We work to help raise mothers' awareness behind the importance of a father's involvement. Sessions help mothers build effective communication skills through personal reflection on their own developmental histories, and by working to show the effect relationships have on their children. The program also teaches mothers important co-parenting skills for raising children when they are not in a partnership with their child's father.

Splish-Splashing Our Way to Summer!


Summer's just around the corner and nothing's more fun than a dip in the pool!
