Annual Fatherhood Forum with Shaka Senghor

Recently The Children's Center hosted the 10th Annual Fatherhood Forum, an event aimed at helping dads and male caregivers become strong role models for their children, families, and community.

This year's event was conducted virtually and there were six guest speakers in the breakout sessions. The keynote speaker at this year's Forum was Shaka Senghor, author of *Writing my Wrongs* and *Letter to the Sons of Society*, who spoke about his book and the role he has played as a father to a black child. During his interview, Senghor shared about the time he spent in prison, away from his newborn son, who had been born just 6 months after his arrest. "For 19 years my dad would bring my son to the prison to see me, and I'd write letters home and do phone calls and I thought I was doing the best I could given the circumstances," says Senghor. "But what I discovered when I got out, was that was not even close to being enough."

The 2022 Visionary Award winner, given by the Wayne County Fatherhood Initiative, is Calvin Mann of Encourage Me I'm Young, Inc. and Good Fathers Only. This award is given to someone who

not only has a vision for change, but advocates for change as well. Through his work Calvin is dedicated to the support and encouragement of boys, men, husbands, and fathers.
