At The Children's Center, we fulfill our mission by keeping children at the center of it all.

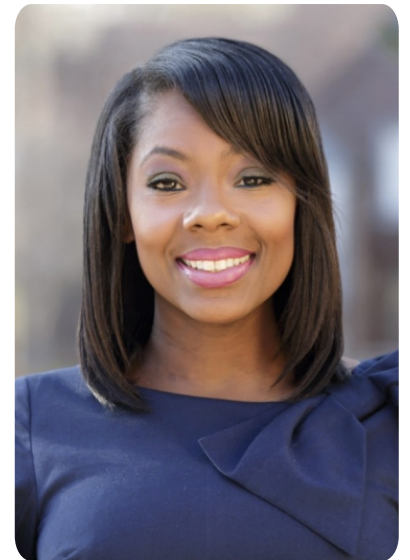

Developmental Disability Services

The Children's Center is home to many services! Diagnostic evaluations for autism and other neurodevelopmental disorders have nearly doubled since before the pandemic. Our doctors have grown from completing 250 evaluations to now completing nearly 450 evaluations per year. We are 1 of 3 DWIHN providers that offer independent evaluations for children facing disabilities. It is our doctors' expertise and vast experience that makes them highly qualified in their field.

Every child undergoes a comprehensive evaluation, which can include interviews, assessments, social observation, testing, and autism assessments. Evaluations are conducted while maintaining a successful path for children under 2 and up to 18 years old, taking anywhere between 2 - 7 hours to complete.

Our team offers case management to coordinate services within the child's individualized treatment plan and is committed to providing the best possible care and support for our clients. We believe that every child deserves a chance to reach their full potential.

Community Health & Wellness Fair

The Tau Beta Family Success Center was proud to hold TCC's first Community Health and Wellness Fair in partnership with DWIHN and Youth United this past August. This opportunity provided TCC families and community members with access to free healthcare and a chance to gather as a community. Vision To Learn and Wayne State University's Mobile Health hosted units on our campus to provide wellness checkups, eye exams, and eyeglasses. Several community partners joined us to equip parents with resources, tools, and knowledge surrounding healthcare access and initiatives. On top of routine care, children also enjoyed playing in the bounce house, participating in Art Therapy, ice-cream, and meeting Clifford the Big Red Dog!

Holiday Shop returns this December, providing a happy holiday for over 1,500 children and their families! This annual event gives parents and guardians the opportunity to pick out gifts for all of the children aged 18 and under in their family.

Congratulations to Kate and all of our 2022 award winners!

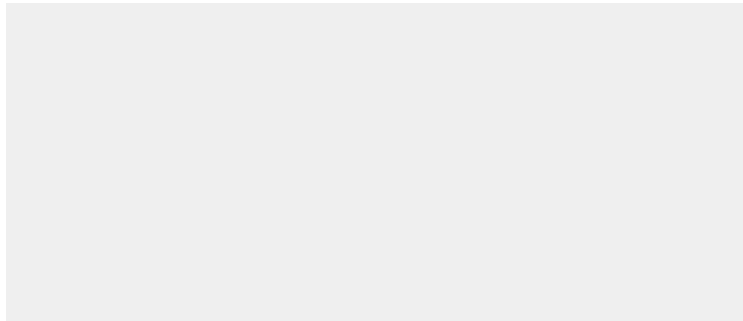
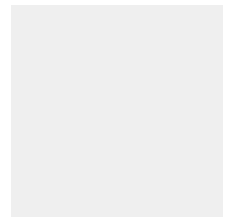


Youth United
